OKC Mile presented by Indian Motorcycle of Oklahoma City will play host to Round 9 of the American Flat Track season featuring the AFT Singles and AFT Twins classes.

**All 2018 American Flat Track events are Pre-Entry ONLY.** Remember to verify that your name is on the entry list. Late entries close June 14<sup>th</sup> by end of business day. No post entry will be available at the event.

### PADDOCK TRANSPORTER PARKING:

Early Load-In will be available from 4:00 p.m. – 6:00 p.m. Friday, June 15<sup>th</sup>. Pit Gates open again 10:00 a.m. Saturday June 16<sup>th</sup>. Pits will be assigned.

### TEAM, RENTAL AND PERSONAL VEHICLE PARKING

All season credential holders will receive one P1 season long parking pass that will be included with their hard card credential. P1 parking pass will be located outside the pit area. Participants who abuse this policy risk revocation of their credential and/or P1 parking pass.

### SCORING TRANSPONDERS

Entered riders will be issued a rechargeable transponder during technical inspection for use during the event. Riders will be responsible for the loss or damage to transponders, unless the loss or damage is the result of a verified on-track crash during official practice, qualifying or race at the event. Transponders must be returned to Tech Inspection as soon as possible at the end of the event or riders will be charged a replacement fee as outlined in the 2018 American Flat Track rulebook.

### FUEL

The official fuel of American Flat Track is Sunoco Supreme 112. If you did not pre-order race fuel on your event entry form, there will NOT be any additional fuel for sale at the event.

### TIRE REGULATIONS

Dunlop tires will be available at the event. Competitors seeking tires are encouraged to call Steve Brubaker with Race Tire Service at (800) 772-8473.

Competitors may only use the specific Dunlop tires listed below for the OKC Mile:

Front tire eligible for both AFT Twins and Singles:

Dunlop DT3 130/80-19 compound F5

Rear tire eligible for AFT Singles at the Red Mile:

Dunlop DT3 140/80-19 compound R8 (Mandatory in all sessions)

Rear tire eligible for AFT Twins at the Red Mile:

Dunlop DT3 140/80-19 compound R10 (Mandatory in all sessions)

### MACHINE SOUND REQUIREMENTS, SOUND TESTING

Per AFT General Equipment Standards and Competitor Bulletin #2017-05, all machines must pass sound test utilizing SAE J1287 procedure. Detailed testing procedures can be found in the appendices of the 2018 Rulebook and Comp Bulletin #2017-05. Pre-event testing can be available Friday, June 15<sup>th</sup>.
